Worthy Brothers,

We had our monthly business meeting last night in the church hall. Quite a few brothers were out of town but otherwise the meeting was well attended. Below are the highlights:

We received a letter from Claire Moreno (Granddaughter of Joe Moreno) regarding an upcoming 4H project she is going to be taking on. She compared it to an Eagle Scout project for the Boy Scouts. Her project is to help support a local Non-Profit called Team 360, a group that helps youth in our community. Once her project is approved she will send us a request for a donation, but she also wants to come to one of our social meetings and do a presentation on her project. This likely would happen in the 1st quarter of next year. Once we have a firm date I will make sure everyone knows so we can show support to her.

Howard gave an update on the Crab Feast scheduled for August 26th. Tickets go on sale this weekend, we have advertisements in the Bulletin and on the Electric sign in front of St. Francis church. We are hoping to sell at least 100 tickets for this event.
